## New US Federal Courthouse, Bakersfield, CA

Gilbane Building Company, in association with NBBJ, has been awarded a Design/Build contract for a new 33,400 SF Federal Courthouse in Bakersfield, CA. This project is a Design and Construction Excellence in Public Buildings award, with funding from the FY 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. The Courthouse will be designed to meet high performance green building design criteria at a minimum LEED Silver. Designed for future expansion, the Courthouse will initially house one Magistrate Court, chamber district clerk's office, U.S Marshals Service, U.S. Pretrial Services and U.S. Probation. The project will be built on existing 2.5 acre park in Bakersfield's central business district. The award was based on an initial concept design and Firm Fixed-Price.
